From the Board

Our updated website **www.jhcc. us** will be going online this coming Tuesday September 5th. The website address is still the same, but additional software has been added to give members a full range of tools to access the club.

The main changes will give members the ability to make golf tee times and tennis court reservations from your own computer or a mobile app on your phone. The app you need to download on your mobile device is ClubHouse Online Mobile (powered by Jonas).

We will be sending out regular statements on the 1st, but you will also receive an email on September 6th with another statement that will include a link to set up your new online account. You will need a few things to register your ClubHouse online account. First, you will be using the exact spelling of your first and last name listed on your account (example...if you go by Josh, but your account is setup under Joshua, you must type Joshua). You must also know your member

account number (which will be listed at the top on the second statement). Just a reminder there are now two accounts for every membership. One is listed as the member (Rxxx or Nxxxx) and the other adult member is the associate member (RxxxxA or NxxxxA).

Associate Member numbers have an A listed at the end.

If you have any questions, please reach out to the office. Secondly, members and associate members will

need to update their email address and mobile numbers on file to be able to access tee time and court times going forward.

Once you have the app installed and registered your account, you will be able to navigate the tee sheet for golf, make reservations for tennis, review all of your club transactions, pay your monthly statements, and find another

member's info listed on the roster.

This is going to be a learning experience for all of us, so please be patient. We realize that this transition will cause some confusion and we expect a few unexpected problems

at first. This is why we waited till after Labor Day to implement these new features. We will not be using old apps for booking tennis or golf reservations that you have after Monday September 4th. If you have issues with the new system, you can still call the office and we will make any arrangements for you and answer any

questions to get your online app up and running. If you find some things that we need to address, please let us know and we will try to correct any issues. Thanks in advance for your patience and understanding.

The pool officially closes Monday September 4th at 8pm.




Unofficially, we will allow members that want to come to the pool access until the weather stops cooperating or we start to run out of chemicals. Please

From the Grounds

The golf course will be closed on Tuesday, September 5th and open back up the following day at noon.



We will be aerifying the greens using the vertidrain. ¾ inch tines will be used and will go to a depth of 7 – 9 inches. This allows us to get a lot of sand into the soil profile, not just the first couple of inches. We have already started aerifying the tee boxes and some high traffic areas. The fairways will be aerified in the next couple of weeks.

There has been a lot of play in the past few weeks and it shows in a few places. Please continue to use the sand and seed bottles that have been provided for everyone, even if you prefer to walk. The greens are also showing some signs with ball marks. Please be considerate and fix your ball marks. A ball mark fixed in the first 10-15 minutes takes only 2 or 3 days to heal, if fixed properly. A ball mark that goes unrepaired can take over 3 weeks to fully recover. The temperatures are starting to get a little cooler, especially at night. This means that there could be frost in the near future. Please take a little effort and realize when the temperature drops to near freezing, that frost is possible. The coldest part of the day is just as the sun appears. There might not be frost to begin with, but it can still form.

We still have the 2 best months left for golfing. If there is anything that we can do for you, don't hesitate to ask.
