The month of May and the few Thursdays in between each track, will consist of traditional Twilight formatting (see format schedule listed above). Signup each Thursday before 5pm, to compete in the scheduled format listed above. All teams and pairings will be made by the Golf Shop Staff.

New this year, we are starting two separate 2-Man Match Play events that will run in tracks throughout the summer. A few key points to this new format:

- Pick your own partner (can be a different partner for each track) or let the Golf Pro Shop help. Get signed up for one or both tracks.
- The cost will be \$20 per match (6 to 7 matches is our goal...all based on participation and flight break down) and will be billed at the beginning of each track.
- Each Thursday will consist of a different 2-Man Match format.
- Signup deadline for Track 1 will be May 18th. Signup deadline for Track 2 will be August 3rd.
- Flights will be determined (based on a combined handicap of both players) and posted one full week prior to each Track start.
- 2-Man teams will need to be signed up by noon each Thursday evening you and your partner plan on participating. Pairings will be made based on matches needing to be played and teams signed up for that given Thursday. We know players might not be able to commit to every Thursday of the summer, so we have a couple of options.
 - 1. Substitutes will be allowed, but only if their handicap is within 3 strokes of their original partner. A list of substitutes signed up will be kept by the Golf Pro Shop.
 - 2. You and your partner can opt out for the week and not play (if you and your partner miss more than 3 given weeks, you will not be allowed to participate in the 2nd track later in the summer).
- There will also be an optional 2-Man Match Skins Game each Thursday during the Tracks. The cost is \$20 per team CASH and will be paid out CASH. Unique to this skins game, a designated hole will be chosen prior to teeing off. One gross skin and one net skin hole (they could possibly be two different holes depending on the random draw). The kicker is the teams will not know the hole until the end of the round. Lowest gross and lowest net score on those blind holes, will win the pot. If there is no clear winner on either of those holes, we will move to the next drawn hole, until we have a skin winner.

**For those not playing in the 2-Man Match Play, we will try and run a traditional twilight format in conjunction with the 2-Man Match Play going on. If the 2-Man Match Play fills for the week, there will not be an individual Twilight. Formats for the individual game each week will be determined based on participation numbers.*

Our goal this year is to make a few needed and wanted changes to the Men's Association, while also rewarding participation in our events this year. Each week, any Men's Association member who plays in Twilight will earn one point towards our season-long race for the Juniper Cup. You can also earn participation points by playing in the monthly Men's Association Tournaments and earn bonus points for placing 1st or 2nd, Gross or Net (in their respective flight), in the monthly tournaments.

Participation is how you will earn an invitation to the Juniper Cup Season Closing tournament. This Ryder Cup format was a ton of fun last season— a tradition we would like to continue for many years to come. The top 40 ranked point earners will receive an invitation to play in the Juniper Cup, including our Top 3-point earners competing for a grand prize.
